The European Cetacean Society (ECS), Europe's largest scientific organization for the study of whales and dolphins, proudly announces its scientific conference under the motto: **"Marine Mammal Populations: Challenges for Conservation in the Next Decade"!**



The conference will be hosted by the German Oceanographic Museum (DMM) in Stralsund, Germany, in March 2010.

Programme: 20 – 21 March: Workshops
22 – 24 March: Presentations and Talks
25 March: Excursion to one of the islands

This will be only the second time in its history that the ECS holds a conference in Germany, so do not miss the opportunity to come! Stralsund is a beautiful hanseatic city, with its old center declared as UNESCO world heritage site in 2002 and a harbour to the Baltic Sea. The new OZEANEUM with its amazing Giants of the Sea is another attraction not to be missed!
